## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission ("Commission") is authorized under the Annotated Code of Maryland, Land Use §17-205 to transfer any land held by it and deemed by the Commission not to be needed for park purposes or other authorized purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Commission owns Patuxent River Park in the Melford area of Bowie, including a parcel approximately  $22.5 \pm$  acres, known as Parcel 8 (tax account 4061800) and further identified as Tax Map 48, Grid A-3, which the Commission acquired by Deed recorded in the Land Records of Prince George's County, Maryland on April 2, 2010 at Liber 31560, folio 151 ("Property"); and

WHEREAS, the City of Bowie, Maryland ("the City") has constructed stormwater outfall pipes running under the Property that convey stormwater to Marconi Pond; and

WHEREAS, City of Bowie, Maryland has requested that the Commission grant to it, for no monetary consideration, a  $4,338 \pm \text{square}$  foot  $(0.0996 \pm \text{acre})$  perpetual stormwater management easement and a  $2,217 \pm \text{square}$  foot  $(0.0509 \pm \text{acre})$  perpetual stormwater management easement, to allow the City to install, construct, reconstruct, maintain, repair, operate and inspect the storm drainage and appurtenances within said easements, together with the right of ingress and egress, for all purposes, in, on, through and over such areas of the Property; and

WHEREAS, the Commission desires to grant to the County, for no monetary consideration, such  $4,338 \pm s.f.$  and such  $2,217 \pm s.f.$  perpetual stormwater management easements as requested by the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Planning Board hereby approves the grant of the above-referenced easements to the City, subject to the approval of the full Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in connection with the transactions contemplated herein, the Executive Director is authorized to execute and deliver, on behalf of the Commission, any and all such certificates, documents, and/or instruments and to do or cause to be done, any and all such acts, as the Executive Director deems necessary or appropriate, to make effective or to implement the intended purposes of the foregoing resolution, without limitation, and the taking of such actions shall be deemed conclusively to be authorized hereby.
